INSTRUCTIONS

- The Roll Number and District be written legibly and correctly in the space provided on the Answer Sheet.
 - Do not write anything on the box of Answer sheet meant for “office use only”.
 - Candidate may use blank space in test Booklet for rough use for solving arithmetic part.
 - All questions carry equal marks. Attempt all Questions. Your total marks will depend only on the number of correct responses marked by you in the Answer Sheet provided for this purpose.
- I. Use Black Ball Point Pen for darkening the circles.
- II. Circles marked like these are wrong 
- III. Correct method of marking of the Circles is 
- IV. Marking of more than one circle will be treated as wrong method
- The invigilator of the Examination hall/room will be the time-keeper and his decision in this regard is final.
 - No candidate shall leave the examination hall/room without prior permission of the Invigilator. No candidate shall be permitted to hand over his test booklet/Answer Sheet and leave the Examination hall/room before of the full time allotted for the paper.
